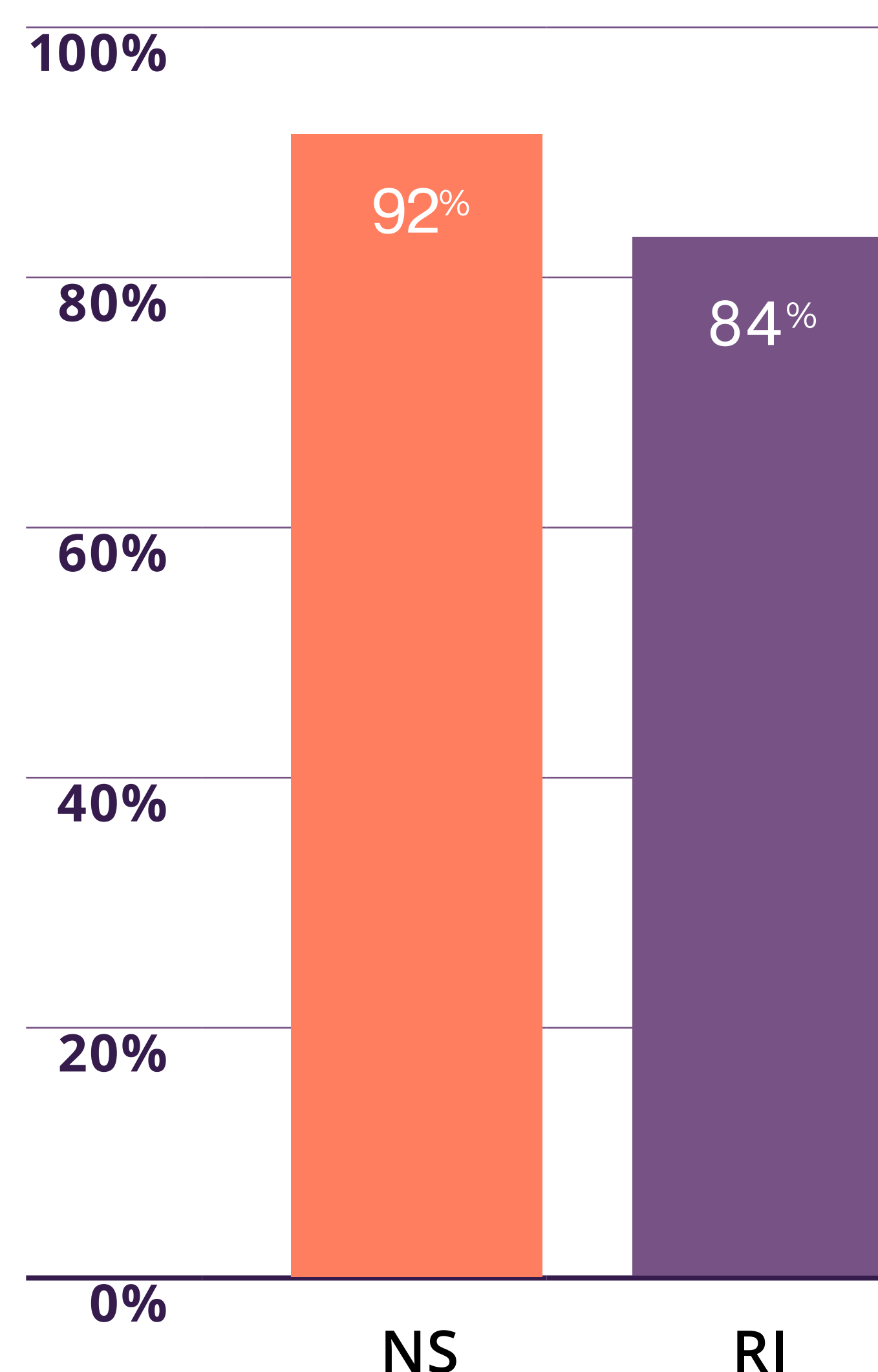
## RI STATE SCHOLARSHIPS<sup>4</sup>

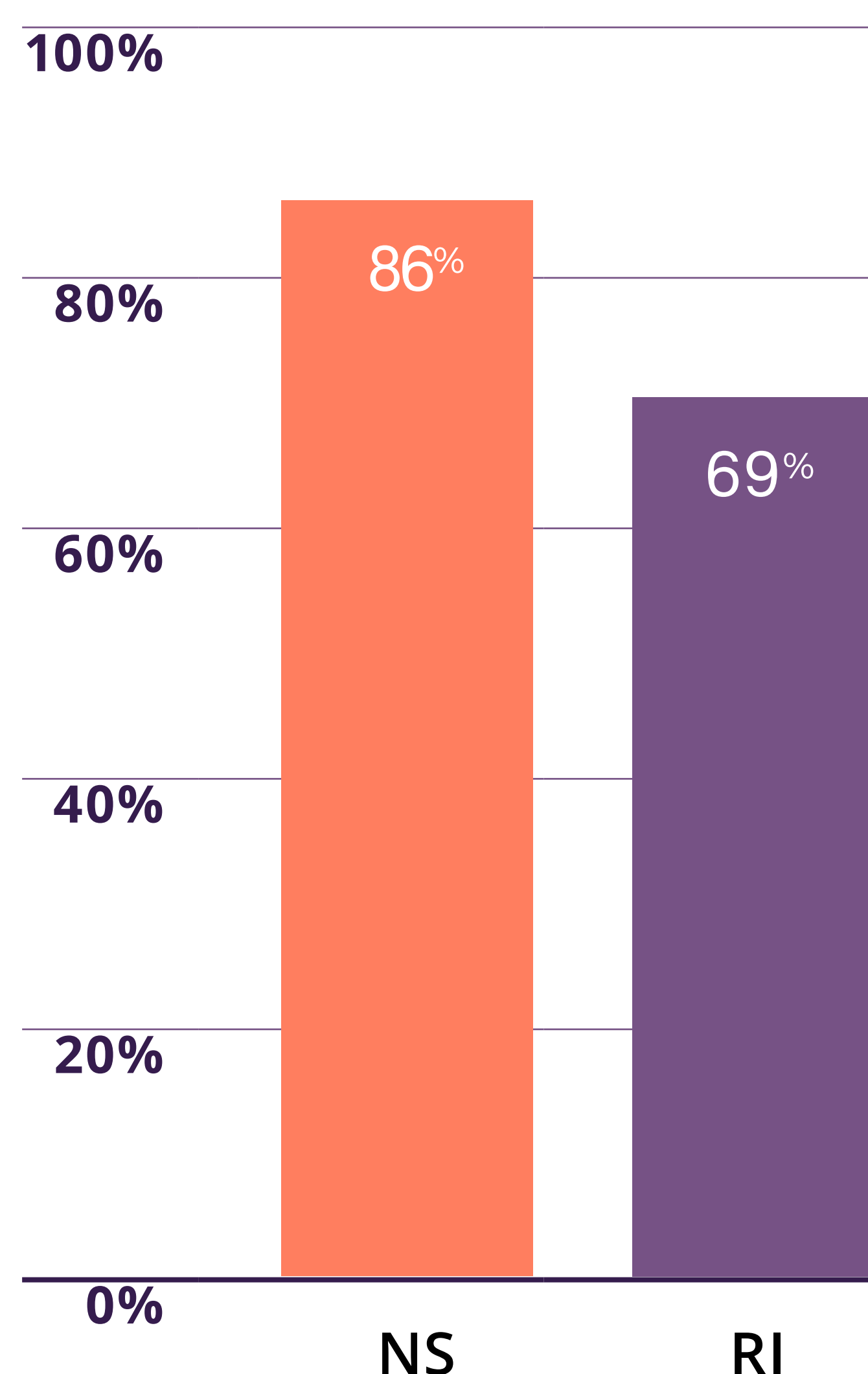
## RI PROMISE<sup>6</sup>
