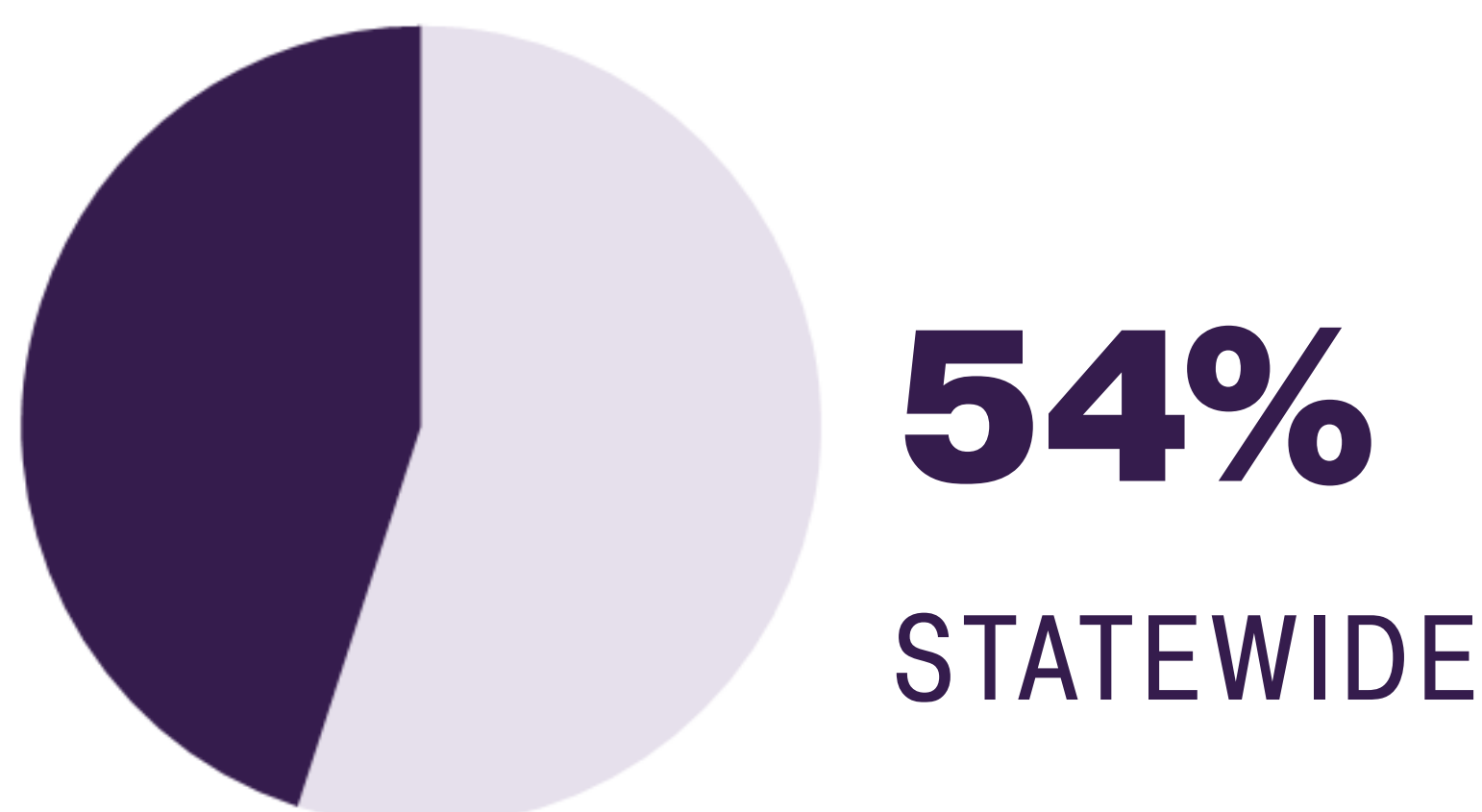
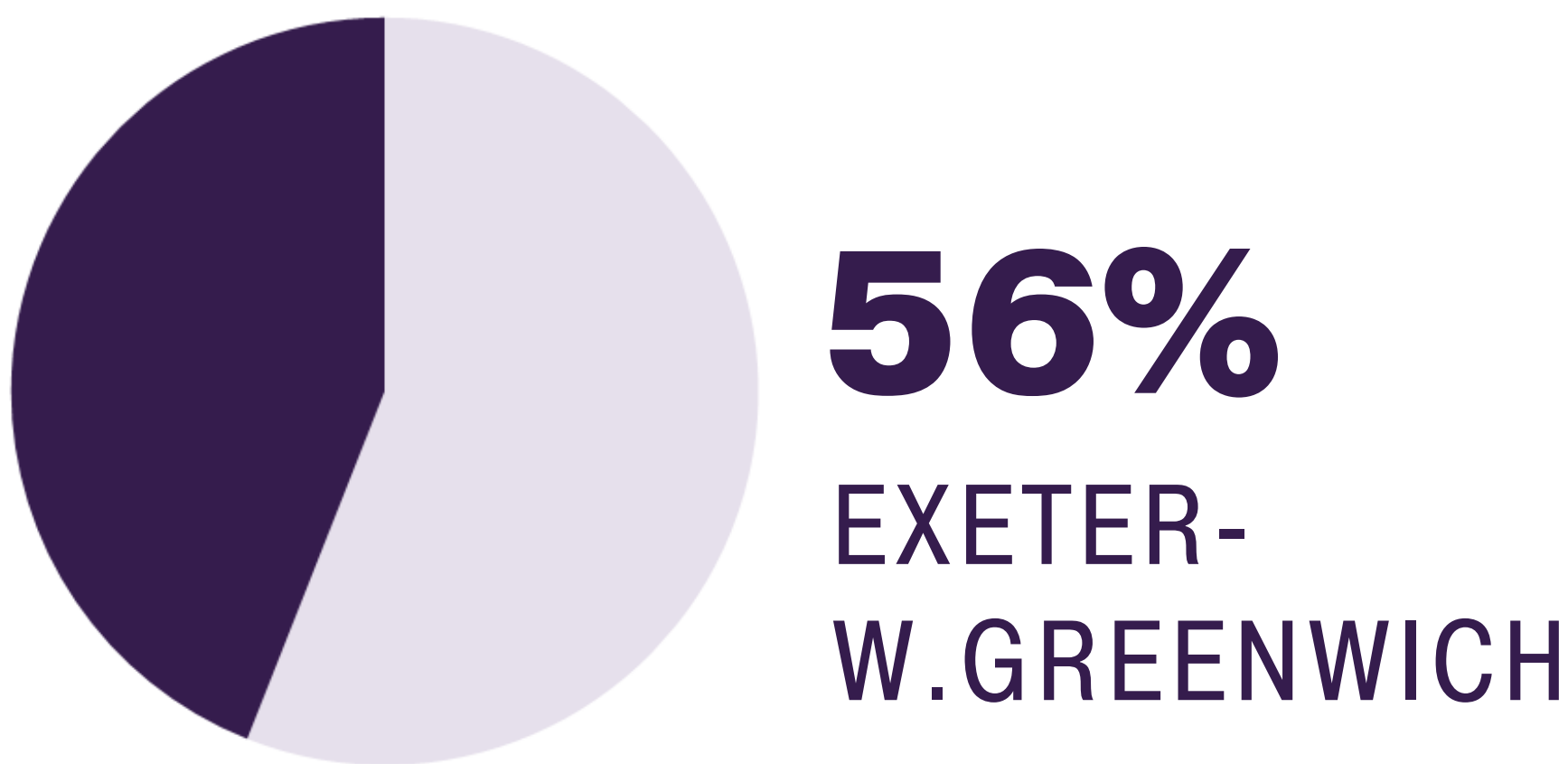

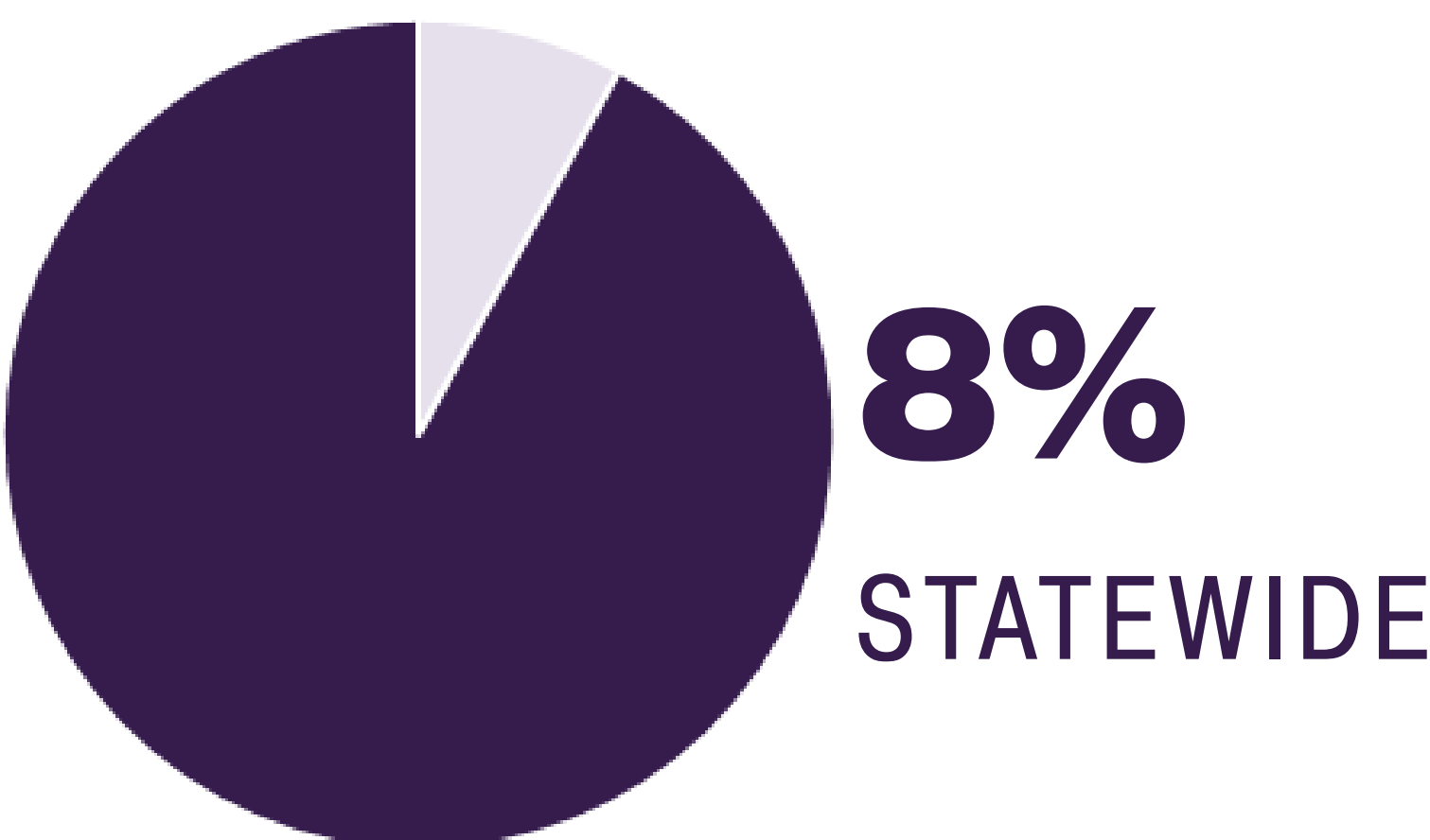
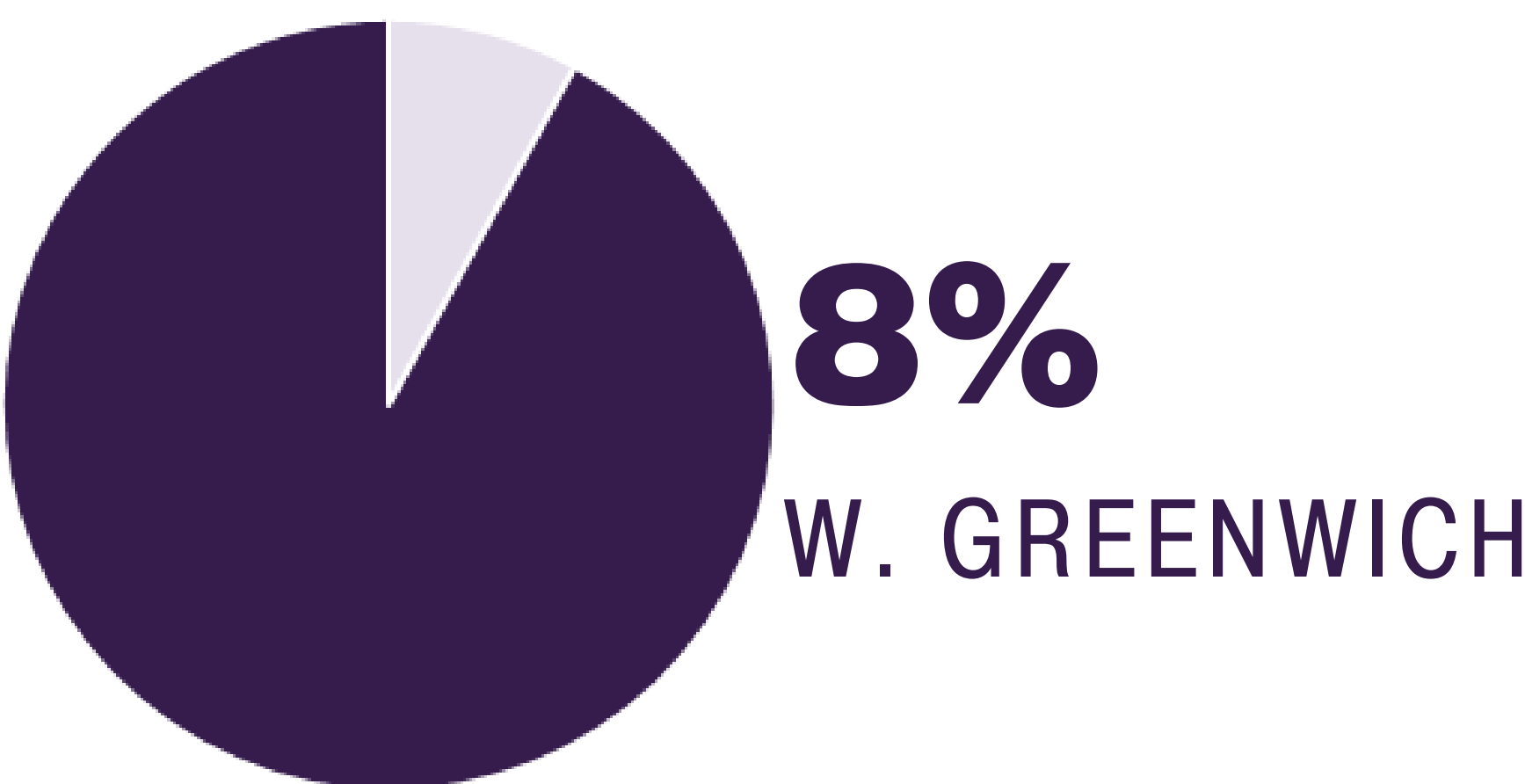
FAFSA COMPLETION RATES³

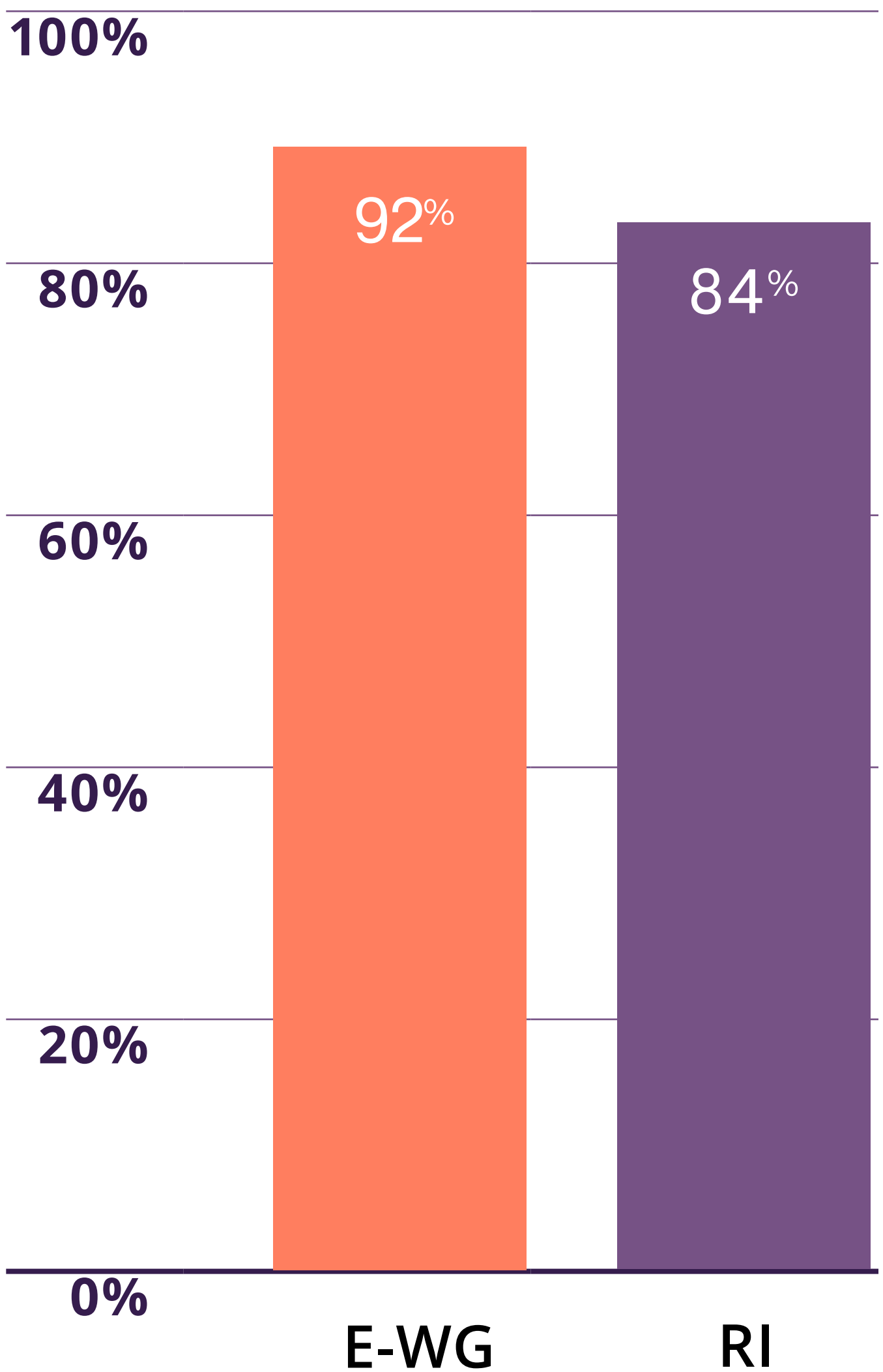
RI STATE SCHOLARSHIPS⁴

\$9,595,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED TO **8,652** STUDENTS AT RHODE ISLAND'S 3 PUBLIC AND 9 PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20. **\$1,109** WAS THE AVERAGE AWARD.

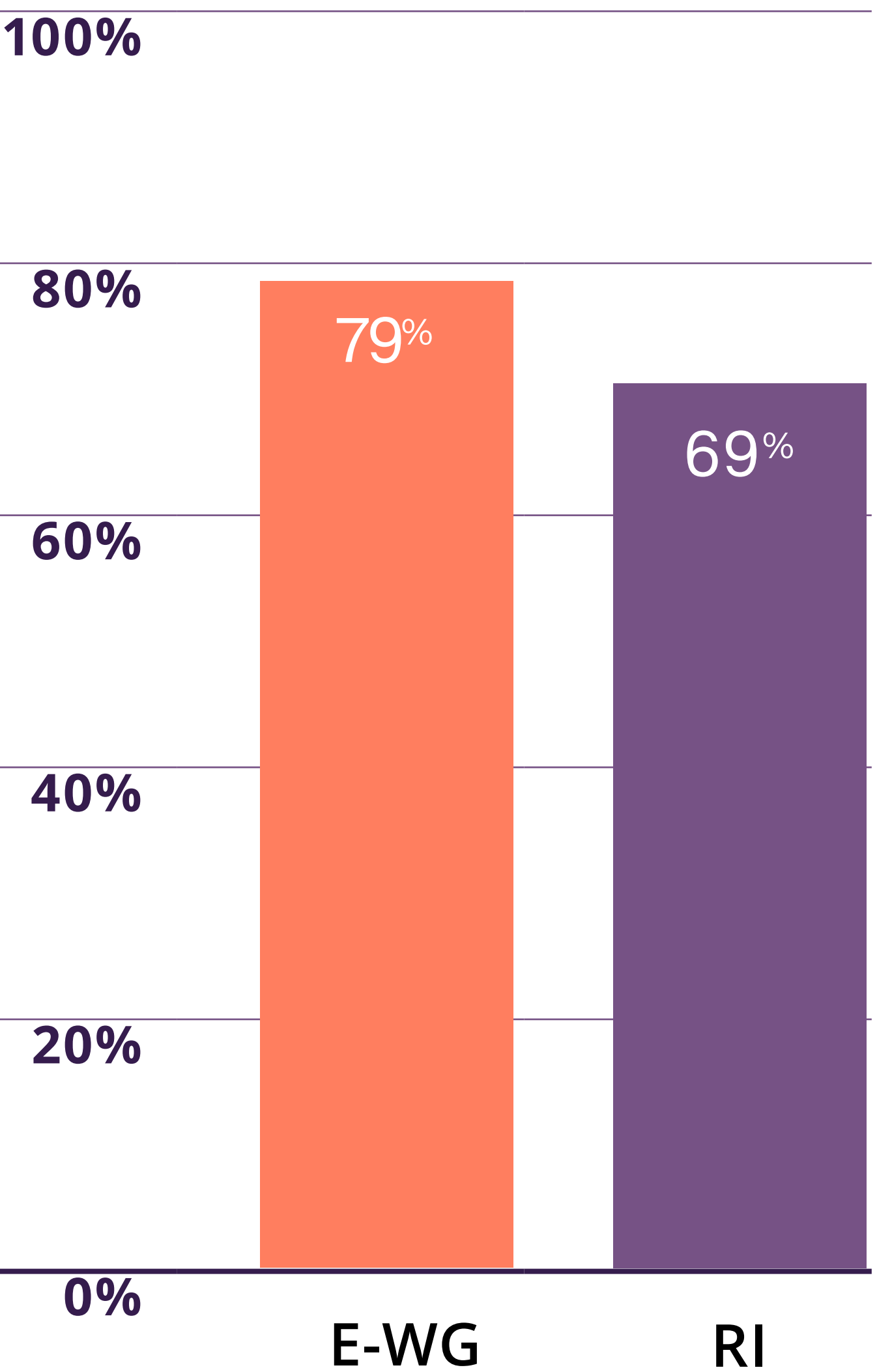
RI PROMISE⁶
