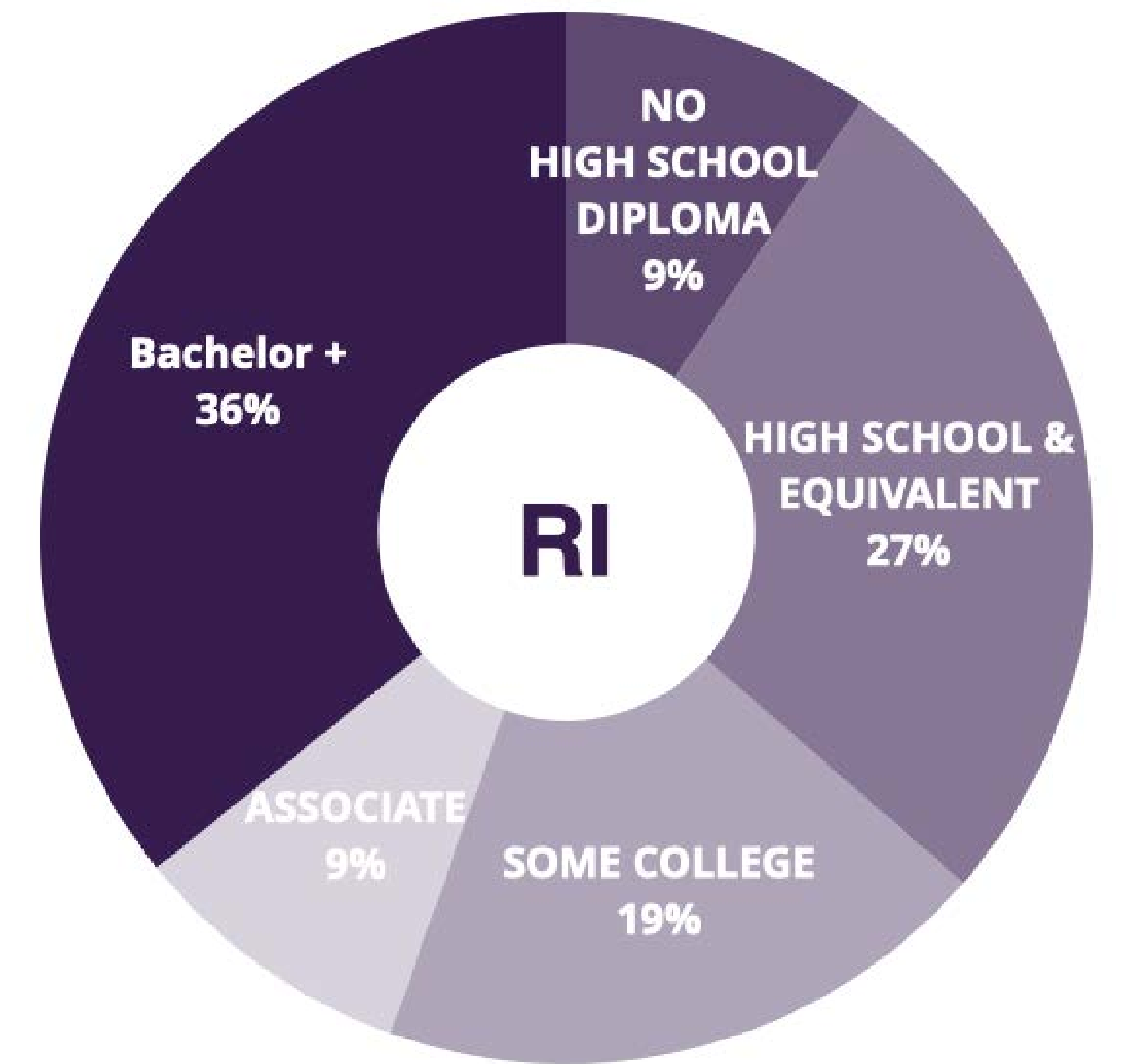
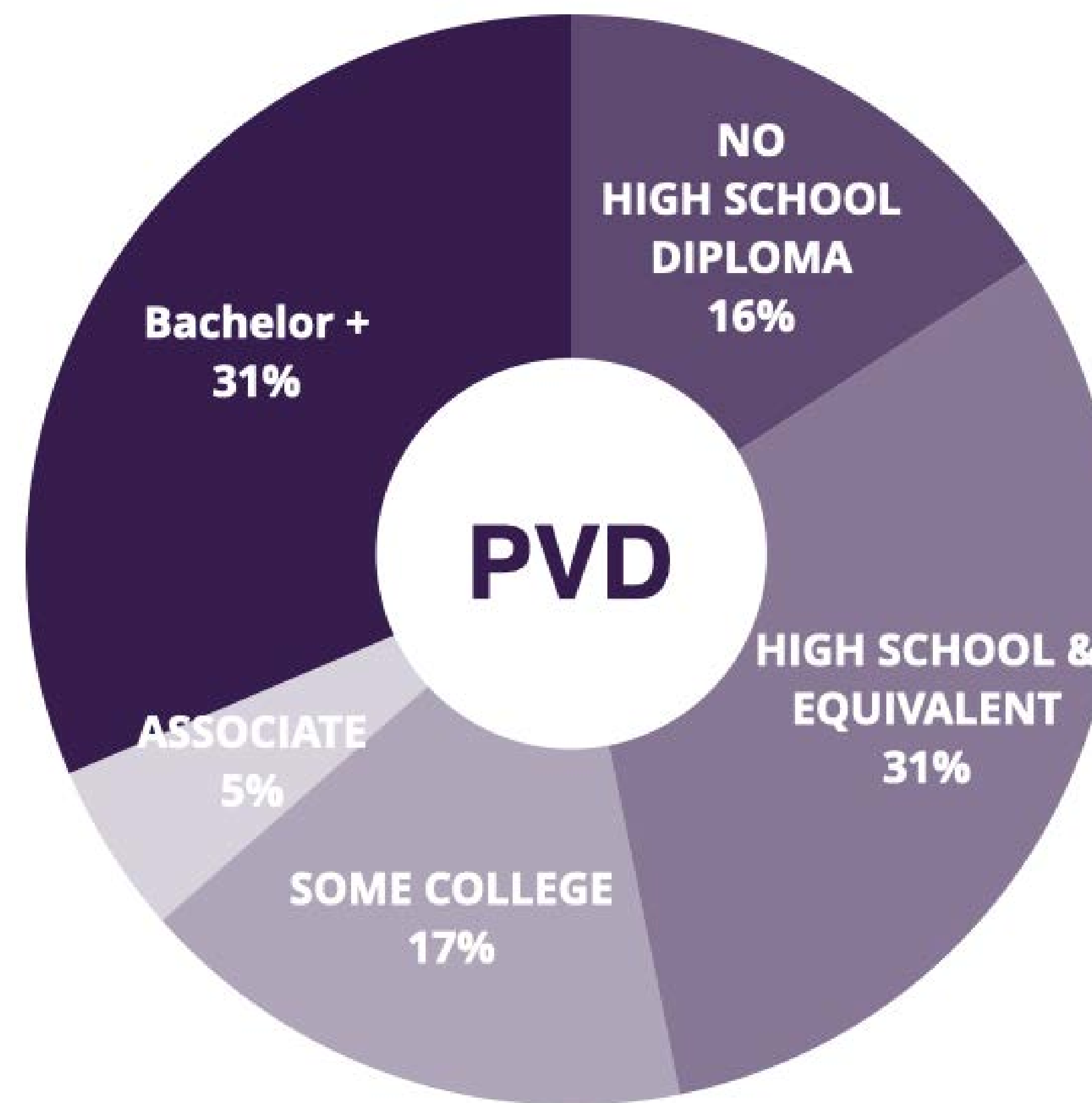

Age 25-64 by Educational Attainment



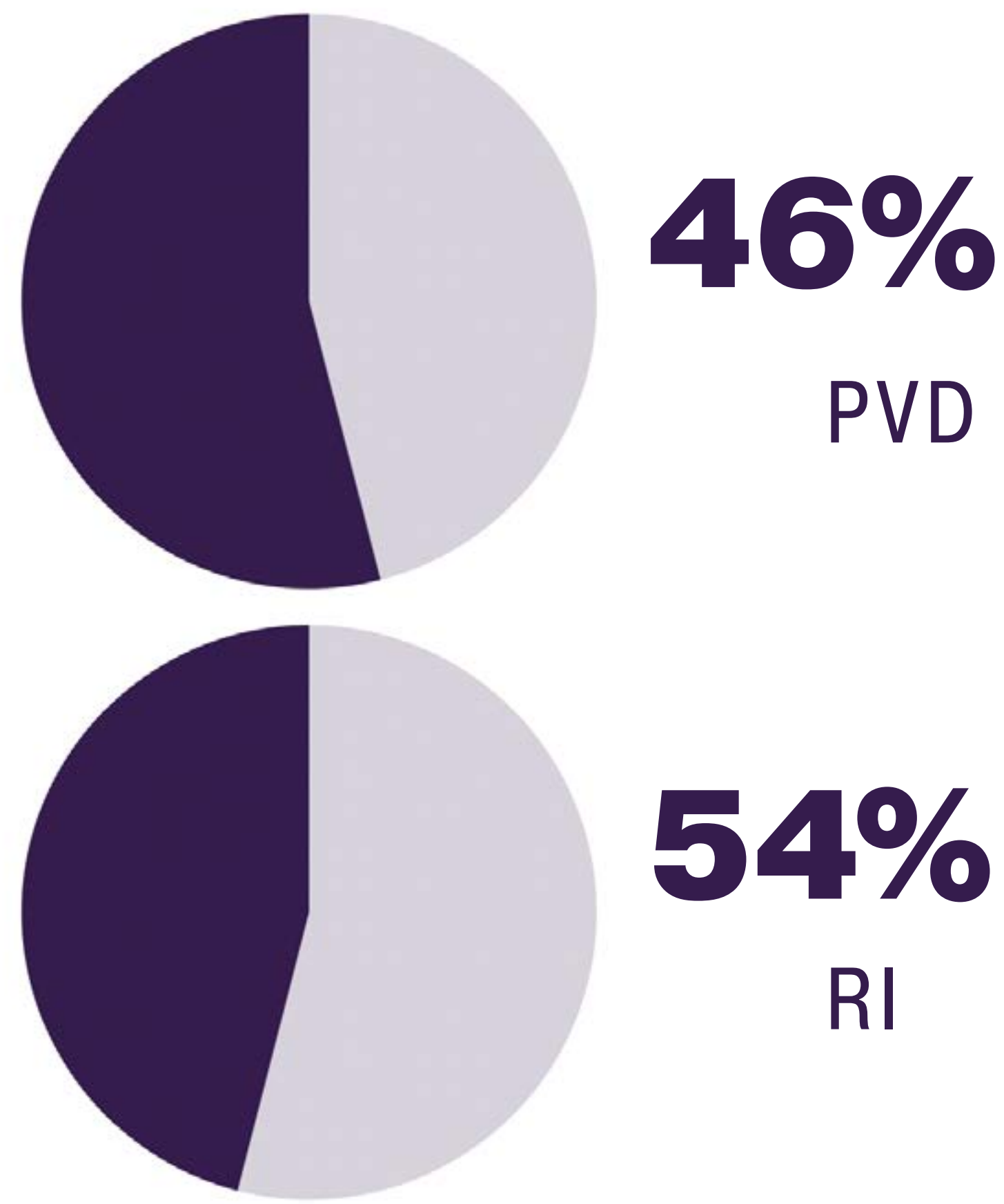

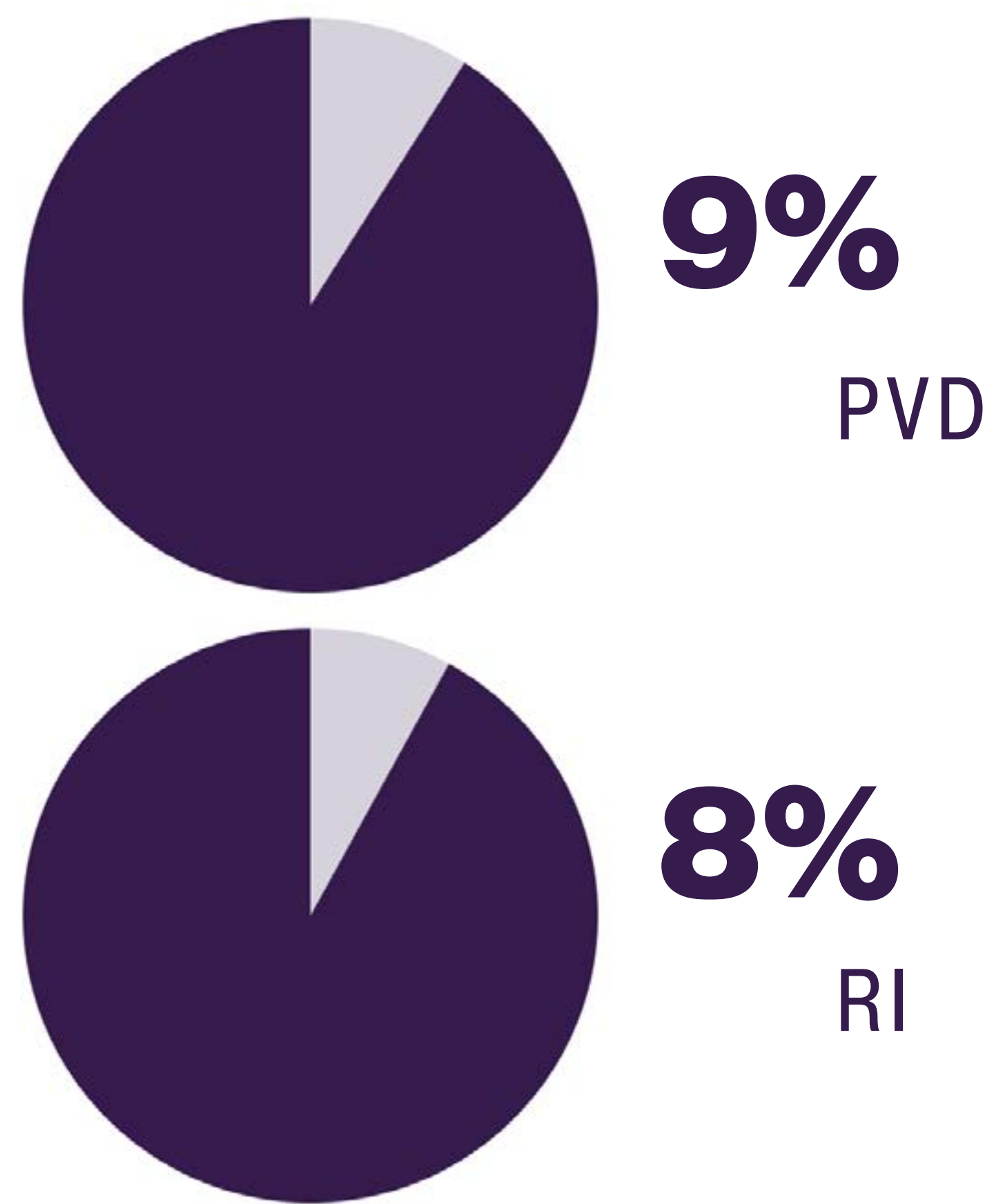

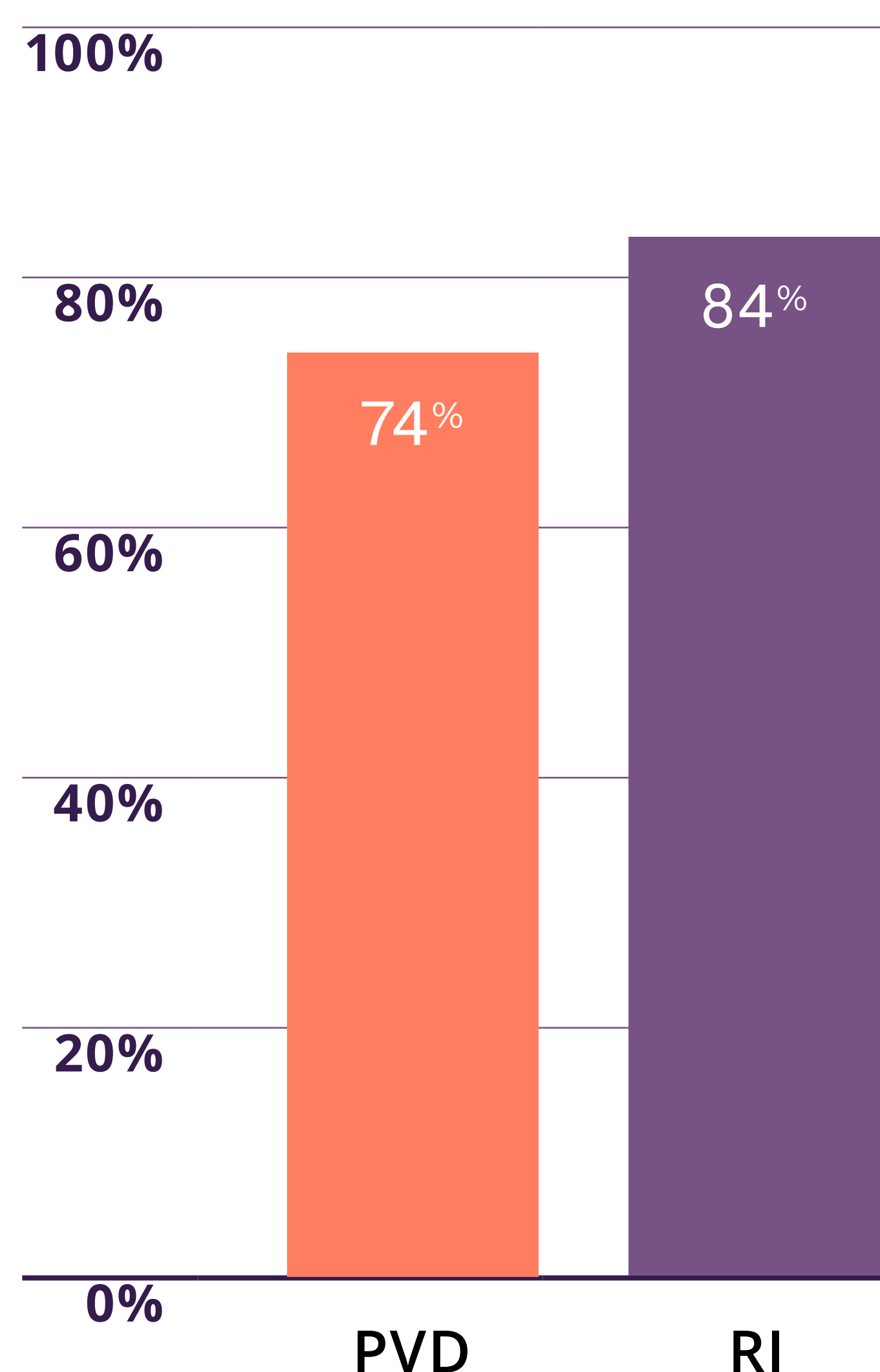

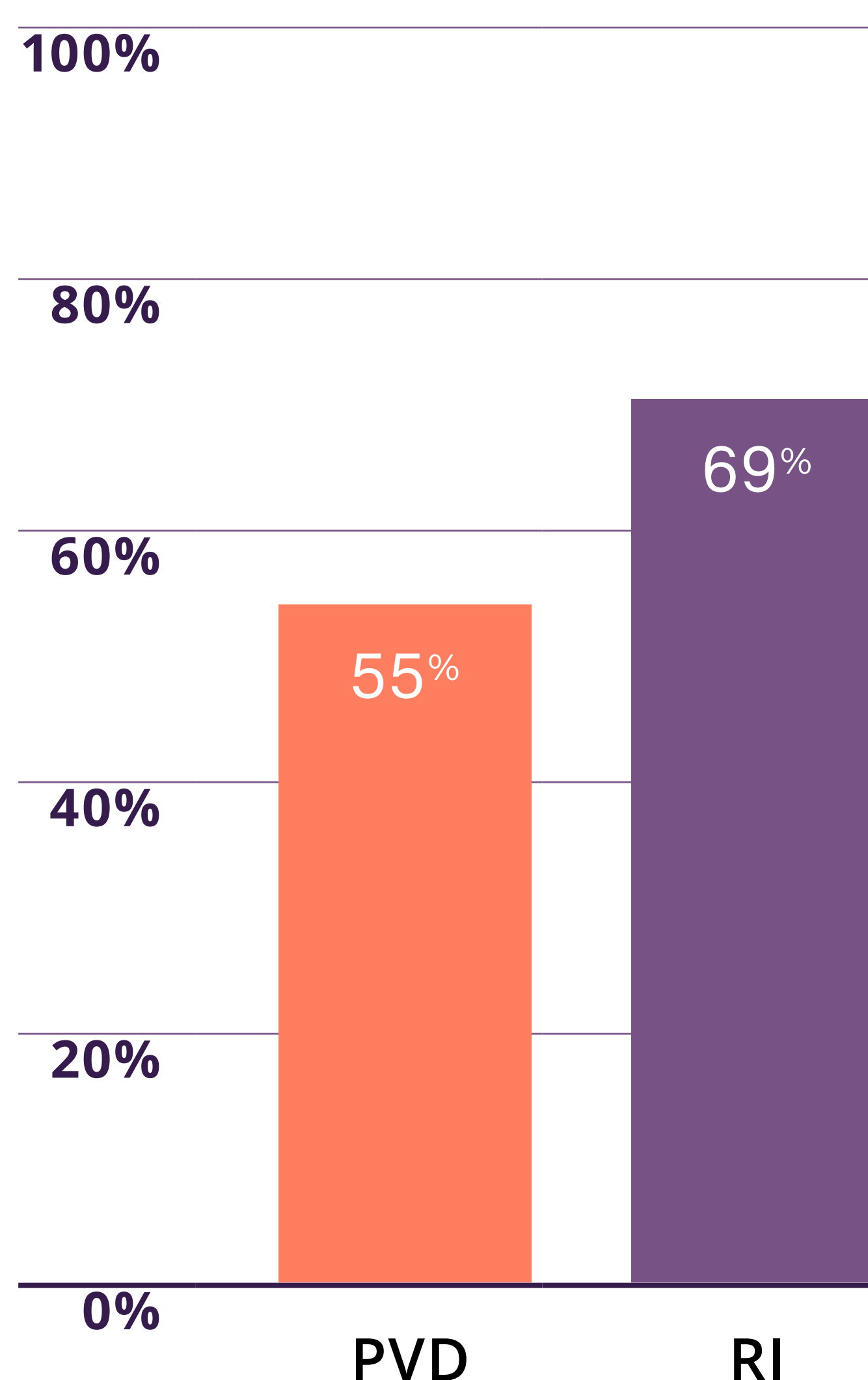
