
FAFSA COMPLETION RATES³ Through March 19, 2021


UNEMPLOYMENT RATES²


RI STATE SCHOLARSHIPS⁵


RI PROMISE⁶

GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL IN FOUR YEARS⁷


