





5,538 RHODE ISLAND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ENROLLED IN A DUAL AND/OR CONCURRENT COURSE. OF THOSE, **41 (1%) WERE BRISTOL-WARREN STUDENTS.**

\$9,595,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED TO **7,574** STUDENTS AT RHODE ISLAND'S 3 PUBLIC AND 10 PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22. **\$1,267** WAS THE AVERAGE AWARD.

CCRI ENROLLED **1,863 RI PROMISE II FIRST-TIME FIRST YEARS** IN FALL 2021. **55%** OF THE FALL 2020 COHORT RETURNED IN FALL 2021.
